EastLink Drop-In



I was privileged to open both the Gidgegannup Show and the Billycart Festival, and provided \$10,000 in funding to help support the Billycart Festival.

- A \$2 million early childhood centre and \$25,000 for a new playground at Mount Helena Primary School.

Revitalising WA TAFE

I'm passionate about our TAFE system and the role it plays in creating opportunities for everyone.

That's why I'm working as part of the McGowan Government to revitalise our TAFE sector. Our plan includes:

- **\$2.5 million** for the METRONET Trade & Training Centre at Midland TAFE.
- **\$282 million** to continue the TAFE fee freeze and reduced fee courses until 2025

- **\$32.4 million** to employ 300 more apprentices and trainees as part of the WA Jobs Plan
