

Investing in **WA TAFE**

I'm passionate about our TAFE system and the role it plays in creating opportunities for everyone.

That's why I'm working as part of the McGowan Government to revitalise our TAFE sector. Our plan includes:

- **\$2.5 million** for the METRONET Trade & Training Centre at Midland TAFE.
- **\$282 million** to continue the TAFE fee freeze and reduced fee courses until 2025
- **\$95 million** for vocational education and training (VET) career support in schools
- **\$32.4 million** to employ 300 more apprentices and trainees as part of the WA Jobs Plan
- **\$29.8 million** to create an additional 9,000 places at WA TAFEs for high school students

Work is now underway on our new train station.

The new station will be located south of The Parkway and west of Civic Terrace, and is set for completion in 2024. When complete, it will serve an estimated 8000 passengers a day, making it one of the busiest stations on the network and taking thousands of cars off our roads.

- ✓ \$500,000 for upgrades to the undercover area, and classrooms at **Upper Swan Primary School**.



- ✓ \$325,000 for **Ellen Stirling Primary School**, for playground and shade sail upgrades, and new appliances for the canteen.
- ✓ Introducing Clontarf Academy and the Gifted & Talented program into **Ellenbrook Secondary College**.
- ✓ New fans and event marquee for **Anne Hamersley Primary School**.
- ✓ Science labs for **Aveley North Primary School**.

- ✓ A sunsafe basketball grandstand, seating and a Parent and Child Centre at **Arbor Grove Primary School**.
- ✓ Upgrades to play equipment and playground areas at **Herne Hill Primary School**.
- ✓ New shade sails, LED signage and new classroom block at **Malvern Springs Primary School**.
